All boat captains are U.S. Coast Guard licensed and use the latest in fishing tackles and marine electronic equipment for catching:

- Lake Trout
- Brown Trout
- Silver Salmon (Coho)
- King Salmon (Chinook)
- Steelhead Trout (Rainbow)

Being the longest established fleet of sport fishing boats in our area, they employ experienced captains to bring the most comprehensive sport fishing in the entire Milwaukee area.

All boats are licensed by the U.S. Coast Guard and the Wisconsin DNR. They also carry insurance from a reliable insurance carrier. In addition to the boat license, all captains are licensed by the Wisconsin DNR.

All necessary fishing equipment is furnished for your charter as well as the most modern electronic safety & fishing equipment.

Boat captains will clean your fish for you so that they are freezer ready.

All boats are inspected for safety each year. In addition, each boat, captain and crew member must meet all federal, state and local regulations. All captains and employees voluntarily submit to yearly random drug testing. All to insure the most safe and relaxing charter fishing experience available in the area.

Directions to McKinley Marina:

Take I-794 East to Lake Michigan. Go North on Lincoln Memorial Drive. Entrance across from the Coletivo Coffee building. Meet near the round building in the boat launch area.

Suggestions for your comfort:

Bring a warm jacket or a sweater appropriate for the weather. Remember that the temperature on the lake is often 5 to 10 degrees cooler than on shore. Include rain gear if the weather so indicates.

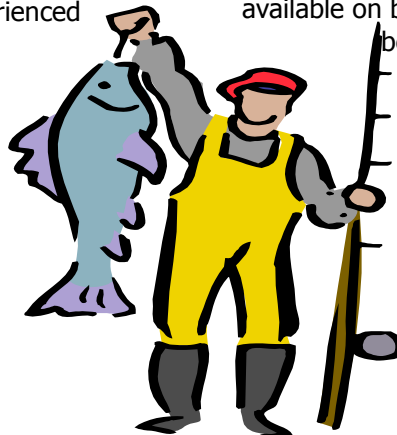
Please wear soft-soled shoes to insure footing and safety.

5:45am –Full day fishing, the boats leave at 6am

8:45am –Half-day fishing, boat leaves at 9am
